EastEdge Dressage Show Rules

Arrival

Show Grounds will be open 6:00pm - 8:00pm on the Day before the show. Trailer Parking will be restricted to Trailer Parking Lots only. These will be well marked areas, please use the space respectfully, and clean up your mess.

****ALL horses coming onto the property are encouraged to have proof of NEGATIVE COGGINS. This can be emailed to the show office along with your entry fees and forms.**

Entries

Entries are due by 7 days before the show date. The entry form should be filled out and emailed to:

All entries must be paid for in full, before they are considered registered for the show. E-transfers will be sent to the above email address as well. Late entries if available will be charged a late fee of \$25 per entry. In event of cancellation for an entry, a veterinary certificate must be presented, Admin fees will not be refunded.

Liability

- It is to be understood that neither Elevation Equestrian, EastEdge Equestrian, SHF, the show committee, judges, volunteers or manager shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, death, damage or loss that may happen, from any cause or circumstances whatsoever, to competitors or anyone on the grounds during the competition (including warm ups) or to any animal or property brought on show grounds or for any loss, claim, matter, circumstance or event in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the show or any journey to and from the show.
- Acknowledgement of Risk form must be sign by all riders before they ride.
- All horses will BE REQUIRED to wear numbers at all times when out of their stalls. We will not be providing bridle numbers for competitors at this show. Please ensure you have a set of numbers on their halter as well as their bridle.
- Schooling will only be permitted in the arenas, paid warm ups in the show ring are available on the entry form. Friday evening from 6-8 or Saturday MORNING 6:30 to 8:00. Warm ups for Friday are \$20 for half an hour block (can be shared), this must be paid before you ride. Please specify the times you want on entry from. Warmups on Saturday morning are not scheduled, open schooling and free of charge.

General Rules

1. No smoking.
2. No pets.
3. All riders must be members of the SHF, this number must be added to your entries.
4. No lunging in warm up arena or near show ring during show hours
5. Any exhibitor not ready to enter the show ring when called will be allowed a period of 2 minutes to enter, after which they will be eliminated without refund.
6. The order of go will be posted and emailed the week of the show.
7. The show committee reserves the right to refuse, limit, accept conditionally, or to cancel awarded prizes; to change any ring or official, to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors.
8. Abuse or inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will also not be tolerated. Above actions may result in elimination.
9. The judge should not be approached and issues can be taken to the show committee.
10. Medical volunteers will be in attendance.
11. Only 50 tests will be offered.
12. This show will follow the SHF rule book. We request that participants carefully read all rules.

Wherein there is no specific SHF rule, we will consult the EC rule book. It is required that all riders wear an approved equestrian helmet when mounted, and in the Dressage Division: A horse/rider may compete in any two, but only two consecutive levels and a horse may compete in a maximum of four tests per day (combined English and Western Dressage) including the Freestyle.

The Saskatchewan Horse Federation works towards achieving the following objectives:

- To provide leadership among recognized equine and equestrian organizations in Saskatchewan that each may be helped to achieve the highest level of success for its members.
- To co-ordinate the activities of the recognized equine and equestrian organizations in Saskatchewan so that duplication of effort and conflict of purpose may be avoided.
- To provide liaison with similar provincial equine councils, and with the Coaching Association of Canada, with the Horse Welfare Alliance of Canada, with Equine Canada, and with any other related national body as may exist for the conduct of sport, recreation and horse industry initiatives in Canada.
- To serve as an educational medium for its members by distributing information relative to the horse industry and equestrian activities by bringing speakers of authority to meetings of the Federation, and by organizing seminars and clinics.
- To develop and deliver programs and projects as appropriate to advance the needs and interests of the membership.
- To serve as a medium through which the provincial government and other agencies may make funds available to support equine and equestrian organizations and activities in Saskatchewan.
- To raise the standards of care and handling of all horses in Saskatchewan. Memberships: SHF memberships can be found at <http://saskhorse.ca/club-membership>

SHF Helmet Policy: All youth under the age of 18 as determined by their year of birth as it appears on their birth certificate will be required to wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet when participating in any event sanctioned by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation. This is for safety and insurance purposes. "

Age divisions: Riders must compete in their Age Division, or Open Classes if they choose, as determined by the Year of Birth as it appears on their Birth Certificate Age Division Year of Birth Junior C 2014 or later Junior B 2011 to 2013 Junior A 2008 to 2010 Senior 2007 or earlier

Heritage and Prairie Cup approved classes will count towards year end awards. Ensure nomination for Heritage or Prairie Cup for 2025 before the start of this show to have points counted toward year end awards.

To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals in 2026, you must have attended a minimum of two Heritage Circuit &/or Prairie Cup Series shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible to participate in any class within that division.
